Re: Improve the level of safety at the intersection of County Road 23 and County Road 20

At its Regular Council Meeting held on February 22, 2022, Council reviewed the correspondence from the County of Essex to the Municipality of Kingsville dated June 25, 2021. Council discussed the importance of installing low-cost safety measures at the intersection of County Road 23 and County Road 20 to decrease accidents. Council further discussed that this is a dangerous intersection and requested that the County of Essex add road markings, a flashing stop sign and lower the speed limit to make this a safer intersection.
